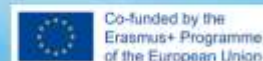

Low skilled people labour market integration is at danger if they don't get proper service support to their specific needs. For this reason, our strategic partnership aims at improving and extending the existent support tools and practices of intermediary professionals dealing with labour market integration of clients that need different, more targeted support services.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the project is innovation, which is translated into create open, flexible and adaptable tools to help discover, document and develop low qualified workers skills.

The project will produce 3 Intellectual Outputs:

- 1. Competence Assessment Cards for Low Skilled Adults;** consist of a profile-screening method especially designed for Low Skilled/Qualified counselling to identify their “basic employability skills”.
- 2. Career Circles™ - Programme Training for Intermediary Professionals,** is a combination of action learning, coaching and peer mentoring principles that provide mentees with a wider source of support and inspiration for idea generation and greater creativity in problem solving during a period of career development or change.
- 3. The Facilitator Guide** consists of a downloadable guide for career advisers in PDF format.

The aim of this is to improve and extend the offer of instruments used in our daily practice.
